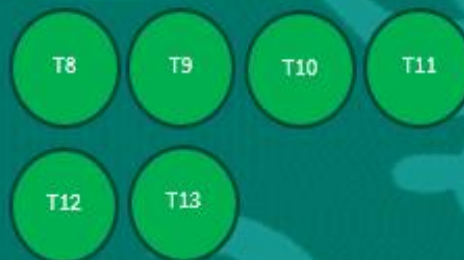
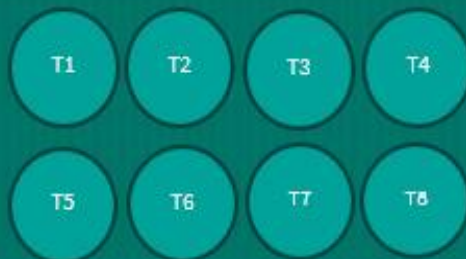

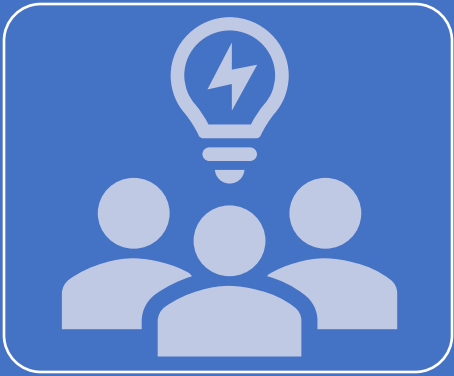

Support actions

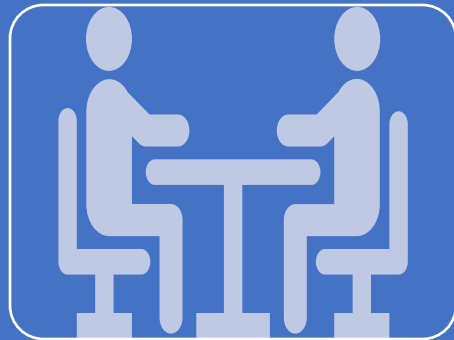
- NBSAPs/national targets by COP16 in 2024
- Early Action Support Programme – co-led by UNDP and UNEP
- NBSAP Accelerator, NBSAP Forum
- Add Hoc Technical Expert Group on indicators
- Thematic workshops, e.g. on ecosystem restoration (T2), protected areas/OECM (T3)
- Network of the regional support centers is under construction
- Global Biodiversity Framework Fund



Role of regional implementation of KM-GBF



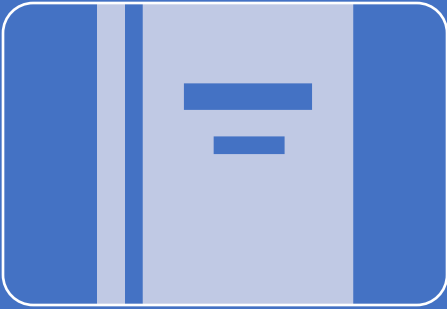
Encourages Parties and other Governments to work with all stakeholders to jointly **implement the KM-GBF** in a spirit of cooperation and mutual support, **at global, regional, subregional, national and subnational levels...** and through existing global, regional, subregional, national and subnational instruments, mechanisms and processes (dec 15/13)



Invites the **governing bodies of biodiversity-related conventions** and relevant multilateral environmental agreements, as well as international organizations and other relevant programmes, **to contribute to the implementation and monitoring of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (dec 15/13)**



Role of regional implementation of KM-GBF



Invites biodiversity-related conventions and other MEAs **to prepare**, following the adoption of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, **thematic capacity-building and development action plans** for specific targets or groups of related targets, and **to develop dedicated global, regional and subregional programmes to implement those thematic plans**, in line with the long-term strategic framework and the Gender Plan of Action, as appropriate (dec 15/8)



Urges Parties and invites other Governments and relevant organizations to provide financial and technical support to biodiversity capacity-building and development activities, taking into consideration ... the special situation of developing countries, including those that are **most environmentally vulnerable**, such as those with arid and semi-arid zones, coastal and **mountainous areas** (dec 15/8)



Invites relevant organizations and regional and subregional bodies, including regional economic integration organizations, to promote the sharing of expertise and information; to strengthen existing regional and subregional support networks or establish new ones, as appropriate... (dec 15/8)

Role of regional implementation of KM-GBF

- Translating complex global Goals and Targets into regional and national actions
- Ensuring a synergetic approach in the implementation of commitments under the various MEAs, regional and global strategies
- Providing a regional platform for policy and technical discussion, experience sharing
- Providing examples for other regions
- Carpathian Biodiversity Framework
- Trilateral MoU between three secretariats CBD, Carpathian Convention and Alpine Convention



Mountain Biodiversity program of work

- Strategic review and analysis by COP16 in 2024
- Program of Work on Mountain Biodiversity was adopted by COP 7 in 2004
- CBD official session (SBSTTA 25) during 15-19 Oct. will consider the overarching gaps and recommend how to organize the review process to compile views and information for SBSTTA 26
- Guidance may exist in other organizations that have a more direct focus/mandate on the Programme of Work on Mountain Biodiversity
- Momentum for countries to raise the profile and visibility of mountain biodiversity to highlight unique challenges and solutions for nature and people
