



- Promotion and marketing campaign














Košice - Miskolc region (HU)

 - GSEISMOPEDSPUR (e-scooter rental)













At transnational level...

- Influencing priority setting in national infrastructure planning
- Integrating in funding priorities (e.g. klima:aktiv mobil)


