4. GETTING TO MIKULOV

Mikulov is easily reached by train, bus or car. We recommend using the **Vienna International Airport** if coming by airplane.

- Limited number of shuttle bus transfers will be available in peak times to take participants from/to Vienna International Airport, provided the requests for transport are timely communicated to the Secretariat of the Carpathian Convention and supplemented by travel details. A shuttle bus is planned for the morning 23 September to bring to Mikulov in time for the excursion of your choice.
- The alternative individual indirect journey by train takes 3 hours (it is necessary to change
 the train in Znojmo or Břeclav) there are several departures throughout a day from the
 Wien Mitte Station. Wien Mitte Station can be reached from the Airport by the City
 Airport Train (CAT) in 16 minutes or by S-Bahn in 25 minutes.

5. VISITING MIKULOV AND THE SOUTH MORAVIA REGION

7. LOCAL CURRENCY

The currency in the Czech Republic is the Czech Crown (CZK) – koruna česká (Kč). The current exchange rate is approximately 1 EUR = 27,7 CZK. Currency exchange facilities are available in banks or eventually at the hotel reception desk. There are several ATMs in the town.

Common payment cards are widely accepted, however some local shops may accept payments in cash only.
