

Objectives

- initiating and supporting cooperation of local stakeholders towards the maintenance, restoration and enhancement of green infrastructure in habitat Natura 2000 sites (Special Areas of Conservation)
- disseminating knowledge on the role and importance of green infrastructure and ecological connectivity for biodiversity conservation, access to ecosystem services and sustainable local development
- promoting the application of spatial data resources and geoinformation tools in spatial planning and management of areas of high natural values
- dissemination of good practices of participatory spatial management in Natura 2000 sites among the Carpathian region countries.













Actions

- **trainings** on green infrastructure issues targeted at local stakeholders, and an e-learning course
- establishment of a **geo-portal** for mapping green infrastructure with the use of a mobile application
- inventory and mapping of green infrastructure by local cooperation networks
- elaboration and implementation of local green infrastructure development plans (competition)
- local informational-promotional campaigns
- manual on protection and proper management of green infrastructure in Natura 2000 sites in the Carpathians
- organization of a joint meeting of 3 Working Groups of the Carpathian Convention (WG Biodiversity, WG Spatial Development, and WG SARD)
