- ✓ The draft strategy for local sustainable tourism development based on natural and cultural heritage of the Carpathians (D.T1.2.3/O.T1.2) presented by LP to CC WG on Sustainable Tourism (15.04.), officially submitted by SCC to CC Parties on 10.06. (with deadline for comments by 22.06., later PL requested extension by 2 weeks, until 06.07.) together with a brief factsheet
- ✓ The draft Carpathian strategy for enhancing biodiversity and landscape conservation outside and inside protected areas (D.T1.1.3/O.T1.1) delivered to SCC together with a brief factsheet (on 07.05), presented by LP to CC WG Biodiversity (20.05.), but not yet officially submitted by SCC to CC Parties







- ✓ 2 pilot actions in PL (A.T1.4 in Pieniny NP, A.T1.5 in Magurski NP) launched, first physical meetings in 2 national parks held in June 2021
- ✓ 3rd pilot action in PL (A.T1.6 communication training for PA administrations) scheduled for 22-24.09.2021. in Muszyna, PL
- ✓ The pilot action in PL under A.T1.5 in Magurski NP physical meeting with national park staff and representatives of local communities and authorities (30 partic.) 21-23.06.2021, Krempna, PL, preparing 4 thematic workshops involving local communities (planned for Sept.-Oct. 2021) towards the development of the local LSTD strategy 2 outcomes







Several community mayors expressed the willingness to conclude an agreement with the NP concerning the local strategy implementation





 By the end of June 2021, all of the 30.000 ha were surveyed and reported.

 20.000 ha of analysed habitat maps were checked and approved by DINPD.







- The preparation of the 3rd part of the background documentation
- Inclusion of the following results:
  - Habitat mapping
  - Forest and grassland state evaluation
  - LiDAR
  - Forest fauna evaluation
- The final output will be prepared jointly with the partners and TTTF members
- In the meantime, several forest management plans were supervised by the DINPD in the area of the Börzsöny Mountains with the use of the background documentation!







- 2 external experts has been contracted for the implementation.
- 3,000 survey plots (points) were determined by DINPD:
- The implementation is going smoothly. Already 1,500 plots were surveyed, the first invoicing and control will happen in July.

Deliverable date: 31. 12. 2021.







- DINPD determined the pilot sites in accordance with the habitat mapping and forest state evaluation sites
- Ongoing tendering procedure







- There is an ongoing tendering for bird and bat species in additition to the forest state evaluation.
- As an additional survey to the implementation of forest state evaluation and nature conservation management planning, an evaluation of the saproxylic beetle species will be monitored.
- Implementation of the beetle fauna evaluationg smoothly.

- ✓ The final proposal of CEST after review by 2 reviewers consulted with TTTF members, finalized with support of the core team of authors.
- ✓ Submitted for proofreading and work on layout to EWS on 25 June 2021.
- ✓ Shortened version for translation to some Carpathian languages finalized and distributed to CZ, HU and PL partners on 29 June 2021.
- ✓ Development of the annex to CEST on the ES capacity in the Carpathian region by experts - ongoing.





- Revitalization process of the CNPA network
- Checked and updated the mailing list of all the PAs included in the former network (about 100), provided by PP3, and new relevant contacts implemented by all the PPs
- Detailed newsletter sent to all PAs involved and contacts from the updated mailing list, in conjunction with ConnectGREEN, SaveGREEN and CC WG Biodiversity, for a total of 1,065 recipients
- Renewal of CNPA official website: design and structure

- Discussion session aimed to foster collaboration and future cooperation among the managers of the Carpathian protected areas.




