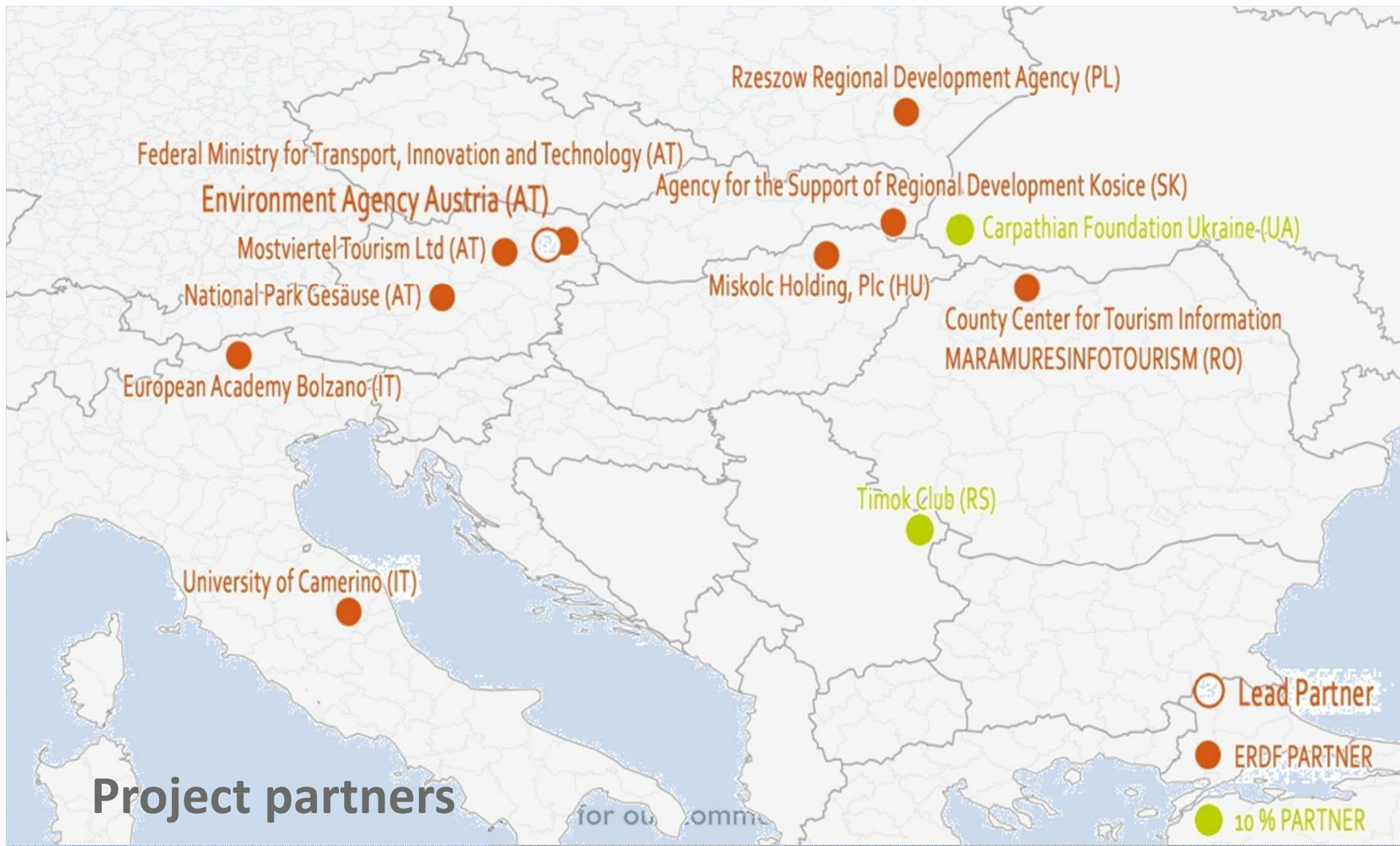

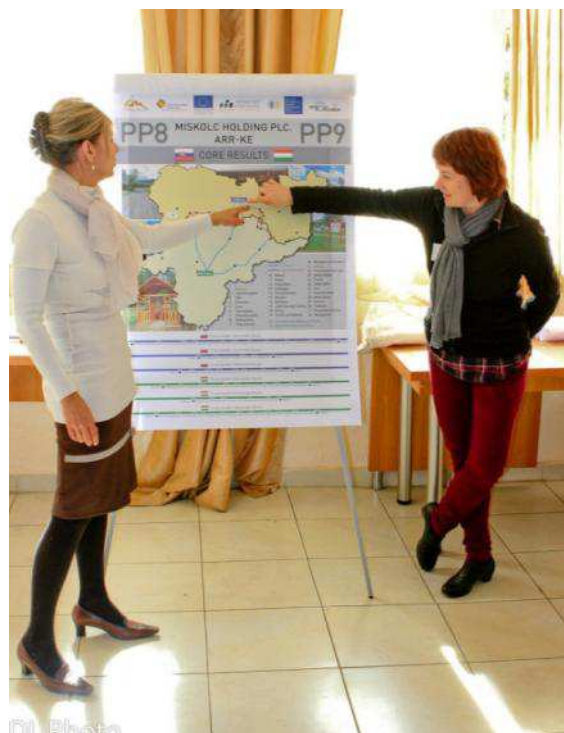

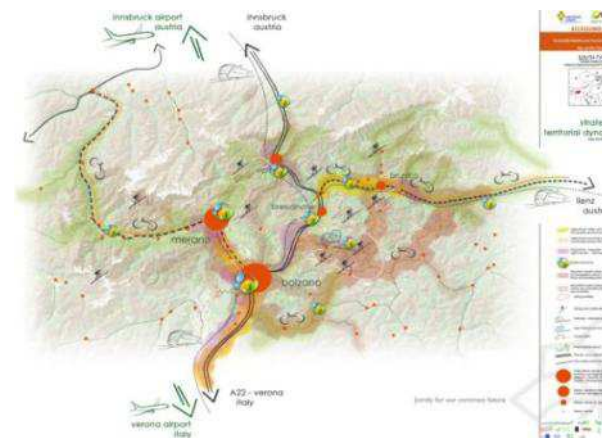

At transnational level...

At national level...

... political, tourism and transport authorities, as well as the tourism, transport and technology sectors must work on a **comprehensive understanding** of the mobility challenge and on vertically and horizontally integrated solutions.

- ➔ National sustainable transport and tourism strategies and action plans
- ➔ Influencing priority setting in national infrastructure planning
- ➔ Integrating in funding priorities (e.g. klima:aktiv mobil)

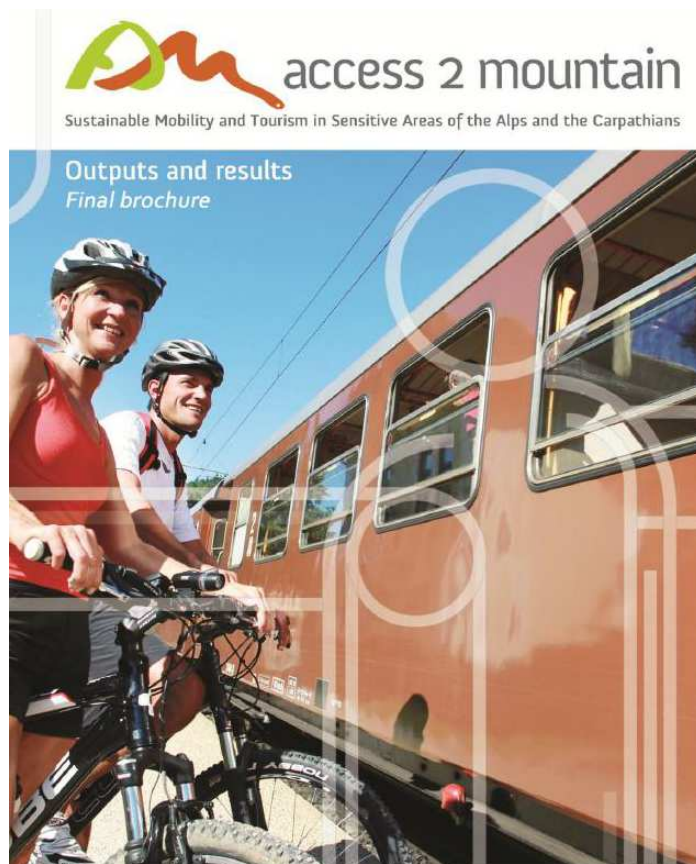


At regional level...
