## The challenges





- Lack of **understanding** the **importance** of **ecological connectivity** for healthy livelihoods
- To **balance** people's needs for safer and better infrastructure while conserving nature
- Lack of experience of authorities and engineers in incorporating the needs for preserving eco connectivity in the planning procedures and eco-corridor identification/designation
- Lack of cross-sectoral cooperation and early engagement
  - Nature conservation, spatial planning, transport, agriculture etc.
- Lack of accessible, scientifically sound biodiversity data
- Low performance of environmental law implementation



- Improved collaboration between Catalogues of measures provide the sectors and across the target countries, awareness raised among relevant stakeholders over 460 organisations were involved!
- Guidelines on Wildlife and Traffic endorsed by 7 Parties to the Carpathian Convention and adapted to national needs in Romania
- EIA Training Package successfully increases capacity in Ukraine & Romania

- good solutions for existing and planned motorways in the pilot areas, uptake into **Defragmentation Programme** in the **Czech Republic**, good basis for **future planning of A8** highway in Romania
- Draft Joint Strategic Action Plan **2021 – 2023** for the Implementation of the Protocol on Sustainable Transport -**Carpathian Convention**






