1. At EU level – elevation of the Carpathian Convention to the status of EU Carpathian Strategy.

2. At the national level in the Carpathian Convention signatory states – coordination of the proposals by Prime Ministers or Deputy Prime Ministers for Economy, due to the cross-sectional, interdisciplinary and international nature of the issues concerning the border regions of signatory states.

3. At the regional level in signatory states – preparation and implementation of joint Integrated Territorial Strategies for the protection and sustainable development of all cross-border sub-regions involved.

The initiative proposed by the chambers of commerce does not involve creation of any new provinces, regions, sub-regions or Euroregions... its aim is to improve synergy between the underdeveloped crossborder sub-regions and to streamline coordination at the national and European levels in order to have the Carpathian Convention approved as a EU macro-regional strategy!
