5TH INNOVATIONS FORUM – TOURISM



Innovations Forum in Rzeszów is an annual event of established international renown dedicated to innovations in different sectors of economy.

It has been held annually in Rzeszów, Poland since 2010 attracting each year more than 600 participants including ministers, members of parliament, local authorities, CEOs of leading branch companies, entrepreneurs, experts, scientists and journalists.

The 5th Innovations Forum is going to take place on 27-28 May 2014 in the modern Centre for Microelectronics and Nanotechnology of Rzeszów University.

This year's edition will focus solely on innovations in tourism. Innovative tourism sector is constantly developing and creates opportunities for economic growth. The tourism industry is considered one of the biggest industries in the world – it provides 255 million jobs and produces 9% of world's GDP. In European Union tourism is one of the largest industry just behind trade and construction industry. So does in Poland. Polish tourism companies employ about 300 000 workers. Moreover, tourism industry is still increasing despite the recession and successfully struggles with unemployment.

Tourism is also very important sector for Podkarpackie Voivodeship. The region has a lot to offer - not just natural resources, beautiful views and nature in its pure form, but also towns with attractive offer for tourists. However, to keep up with the changing market it is necessary to implement innovations. That makes innovations worth to discuss.

The Innovations Forum will be an opportunity to analyze the Polish and European tourism market and to present innovative technologies which occurred in Podkarpackie Region during recent years. The forum will open with plenary session on Sources and Limits of Innovations in Tourism. Parallel discussion panels will follow covering broad aspects of innovations in tourism industry.

Carpathian States Tourism Forum Rzeszów, Poland 28 May 2014

1st Carpathian States Tourism Forum will be held in Rzeszów, Poland on 28 May 2014 on the initiative of Ministry of Sport and Tourism of the Republic of Poland.

1st CSTF will be attended by representatives of government institutions, NGOs, scientists and entrepreneurs from the tourism sector of the Carpathian countries. The aim of the Forum is to create a platform for cooperation and exchange of knowledge on tourism basing on the provisions of the Carpathian Convention and Protocol on Sustainable Tourism.

The Forum's scope includes tourism products development, marketing and implementation of joint projects in the field of tourism with special focus on sustainable tourism in the Carpathian countries.

The intention of the organizers is to launch a new initiative of annual meetings held each time in a different Carpathian state.

Meeting of Tourism Ministers of the Carpathian States will be organized back to back to the Forum on 28 May allowing the high level discussion on essential for tourism in the Carpathians issues.

Poland is a party to the Framework Convention on the Protection and Sustainable Development of the Carpathians, signed in Kiev on May 22, 2003 (Carpathian Convention). Parties to the Convention are also the Czech Republic, Serbia, Hungary, Romania, Slovak Republic and Ukraine. The areas managed by the Convention are: conservation of biodiversity and landscape, spatial planning, water management, agriculture and forestry, transport and infrastructure, industry and energy, cultural heritage, as well as sustainable tourism.

Currently, Strategy for Sustainable Tourism Development of Carpathians is being drafted under the auspices of the Interim Secretariat of the Carpathian Convention. The Strategy will implement the provisions of the Protocol on Sustainable Tourism to the Framework Convention on the Protection and Sustainable Development of the Carpathians.



The Carpathians are one of Europe's largest mountain ranges, a unique natural treasure of great beauty and ecological value, and home of the headwaters of major rivers.
