#### **Topic**

- Maintaining and restoring ecological connectivity.
- Need for transnational and cross-sectoral cooperation.

#### **Overall goal**

- To develop and commit to a coordinated cross-border and cross-sector approach for spatial planning and nature conservation in the region.
- To present the Declaration in a workshop held at the EUSDR Annual Forum in autumn 2022.
