


EU Green Deal – Biodiversity Strategy 2030

- Create a Transnational European Network of Nature (TEN-N) that includes a functionally connected system with ecological corridors
- ...making best use of other targets:
- Legally protect at least 30% of land, including inland waterways
- Legally protect at least 30% of land & sea
- Strictly protect 10%
- Protected areas with clear conservation objectives and appropriate monitoring

Objectives of NaturaConnect




- Define blue-print for TEN-N

- Develop future scenarios incorporating existing climate and land-use projections


