- Contribution to the **awareness of the specificity of mountain biodiversity** at the national and international level;
- Contribution to the achievement of European and international objectives



Advance in the development of the project

- Development of an **IT tool for the cartographic representation and monitoring of alpine biodiversity**, also as a useful IT tool for an early warning system of endangered species and for spatial planning.
- Disseminate the intermediate **results of the planned ABB project** for the construction of the IT tool to facilitate the integration of mountain biodiversity strategies into national strategies

Mandate outputs 2023-2024

General Objectives:

Contribute to **implementing the two Biodiversity Pathways of the Climate Action Plan 2.0**, elaborated between the ABB and the ACB:

- 1) "Protection and management of vulnerable and Alpine-specific landscapes and ecosystems" and
- 2) "Enhance transboundary cooperation and ecological connectivity".



Climate actions

- Disseminate the intermediate results of the planned ABB project
- Report and recommendations for optimizing the knowledge and inclusion of Alpine specificity within national Biodiversity strategies.
- Prepare elements for a draft mid-term Action Plan for biodiversity

Support the **global ecosystem restoration efforts in the Alps** and raise the profile of the Alps as a model region in this field.



Alps as a model region

- Application to become a Supporting Partner to the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration.
- First collection of **ecosystem restoration efforts in the Alps**, and communication to the UN DER

Mandate Outputs 2023-2024

ABB action under the mandate

- ✓ Illustration of proposed activities
- 1) Cooperation and International activities
 - Continue cooperation with other TWBs of the AC, in particular ACB, WISO and MAMF
 - <u>Implementation of the Memorandum of Cooperation between the three Conventions CBD, AC, CC</u>
 - Continue and strengthen collaboration with CC, UNEP, MP FAO, EUSALP, UN DER

ABB action under the mandate

- ✓ Illustration of proposed activities
- 2) Finalize the project proposal and its partnership for a forthcoming call;
 - The project can be defined before the end of this mandate
 - Promoting a sharing of the method
 - Importance of **mapping for the monitoring of biodiversity** at the alpine level
 - Promoting the cooperation with other regions like the Carpathians on mapping and monitoring biodiversity in mountain regions

- 3) Organize international workshops of thematic in-depth study, with the coordination of ABB and in cooperation with other TWBs
 - Mountain biodiversity in the national and EU biodiversity strategies (DE) (organized on 17th April 2023)

 - Biodiversity and Climate Change (AT)
 - Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (CH)
 - Biodiversity and Quality of Life (SI)
 - Biodiversity and Land Use Planning (IT/DE)
