## Implementation of EU Timber Regulation in Romania

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26<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 Brașov





The EUTR was adopted in December 2010 but only entered into application on 3 March 2013.

The EUTR establishes the following three key obligations:

- ➤ It prohibits the placing on the market of illegally harvested timber or timber products derived from such timber;
- ➤ It requires operators who place timber products on the EU market for the first time to exercise 'due diligence' (DD);
- It requires traders in timber and timber products after the first placement on the market to keep records of their suppliers and customers.



- Adoption and publication of Government Emergency Ordinance (GEO) no. 51/2016 amended and supplemented Law No. significantly. 171/2010 for establishing and sanctioning contraventions forest.
- The purpose of the ordinance was to increase the penalties for the operators that are placing for the first time on the market timber and timber products (for achieving the goals of the implementation of Regulation (EU) no. 995/2010).
- > the value of 8.000-15.000 lei (1.800-3.300 Euro) for not using a system "Due diligence".

> Complementary penalty - confiscation of wood and means of transportation for the situations of transport without legal origin of wood materials.
