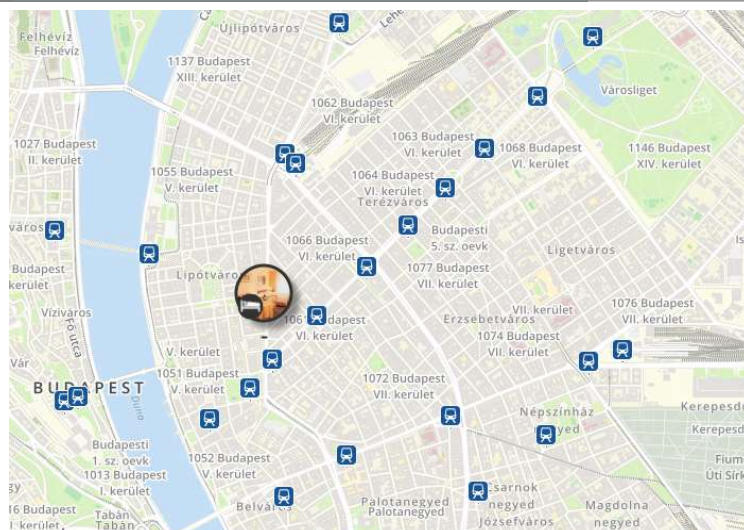

Local Transport from railway stations	<p>From Train Station East (Keleti Pályaudvar), Underground line M2 (red line) to Deák Ferenc Square, change to M1 (yellow line), 2 stops to Opera. (10 minutes) Train arrives here from Wien.</p> <p>From Train Station West (Nyugati pályaudvar): Underground line M3 (blue line) to Deák Ferenc Square, change to M1 (yellow line), 2 stops to "Opera". (8 minutes)</p> <p>Train Station South (Déli pályaudvar): Underground line M2 (red line) to "Deák Ferenc Square", change to M1 (yellow line), 2 stops to "Opera". (18 minutes)</p>
Driving from Highway M1, M7	<p>At the end of highway M7 or M1 - follow the sign Centrum. Take Petőfi híd (bridge) across the Danube to the Pest side. Continue to Oktogon square; there you have to turn right and then immediately left onto Andrásy utca. Turn right into Káldy Gyula utca (second street past the Opera House to the right) and right again into Révay utca.</p>
Driving from Highway M2, M3	<p>At the end of highway M2 and M3 - follow the sign Centrum. Take Váci (út) road, go straight to Bajcsy Zs. Út turn to the left on Andrásy utca. Turn right into Káldy Gyula utca (second street past the Opera House to the right) and right again into Révay utca.</p>
Driving from Highway M5	<p>At the end of highway M5 - follow the sign Centrum.</p>
Public transport from airport	<p>Take 100E bus, available every 20 minutes, stops in front of the terminal, terminates to "Deák Ferenc Square". Change to M1 (yellow line), 2 stops to "Opera". (50 minutes)</p>
Taxi	<p>Taxi station is located in front of the terminal.</p>

About Budapest	<p>Budapest is the capital and the most populous city of Hungary.</p> <p>The city had an estimated population of 1,752,704 in 2016 distributed over a land area of about 525 square kilometers (203 square miles). Budapest is both a city and county, and forms the centre of the Budapest metropolitan area, which has an area of 7,626 square kilometers (2,944 square miles) and a population of 3,303,786, comprising 33 percent of the population of Hungary.</p> <p>Budapest is cited as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe, ranked as "the world's second best city" by Condé Nast Traveler. Among Budapest's important museums and cultural institutions is the Museum of Fine Arts. Further famous cultural institutions are the Hungarian National Museum, Franz Liszt Academy of Music, Hungarian State Opera House and National Széchenyi Library. The central area of the city along the Danube River is classified as an UNESCO World Heritage Site and has many notable monuments, including the Hungarian Parliament, Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, Gresham Palace, Széchenyi Chain Bridge, Matthias Church and the Liberty Statue. Other famous landmarks include Andrassy Avenue, St. Stephen's Basilica, Heroes' Square, the Great Market Hall, the Nyugati Railway Station built by the Eiffel Company of Paris in 1877 and the second-oldest metro line in the world, the Millennium Underground Railway. The city also has around 80 geothermal springs.</p> <p>https://www.budapest.com/</p>
