COP7 Decisions related to Carpathian ESD

- Welcomes the Carpathian Education for Sustainable
 Development (ESD) Expert Network as a cross-sectoral network of diverse actors
 - facilitating cross-thematic linkages, expanding and strengthening Convention networks, and communication within the Convention and awareness-raising about the Convention
 - encourages the Parties, who have not done so yet, to nominate
 Carpathian ESD experts to the network
- Encourages the cooperation among the Focal Points and the ESD Experts
- Invites the Parties to explore the possibility of **establishing**"Carpathians Convention Youth Focal Point" in order to increase the engagement of young people in this process.
- Welcomes the Side Event "ESD Expert Network in the Carpathian Region", held within the 9th Environment for Europe (EfE) Conference on 5th October 2022, Nicosia, Cyprus...





COP7 Decisions related to Carpathian ESD

- Welcomes the process of developing the Vision and Strategy for Carpathian ESD by the Carpathian ESD Experts...
- Welcomes the Carpathian ESD Session and Workshop, organized ... during the 7th Forum Carpaticum ... invites the Parties to consider ... recommendations in cooperation with relevant stakeholders.
- Requests the Secretariat to continue its liaison with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) Steering
 Committee on ESD and UNESCO as relevant, and to explore collaboration with the Global Education Network Europe (GENE).
- Invites the Serbian Presidency of the Carpathian Convention to continue supporting ESD activities as a necessary tool to enable long-term sustainable development in the Carpathians.



COP7 Decisions related to Carpathian Day

• Welcomes the idea of establishing the Carpathian Day to further promote the protection and sustainable development of the Carpathians and the Carpathian Convention activities at various levels; invites the Parties, relevant stakeholders, and the Secretariat to contribute to the process, as appropriate.

Welcomes the outcomes of the second Carpathian ESD Seminar, held in Zakopane, Poland, on 28-30 September 2022 ... and requests the Secretariat and invites the Parties to consider the recommendations elaborated at the Seminar, including providing support to the Carpathian ESD Experts in following up on the outputs and recommendations received at the Seminar, particularly on organization of a Carpathian Day. Support provided by Cyprus to CESDEN

- Support provided by the Ministry of Education of Cyprus
- For a 3-year period of Serbian presidency of the Carpathian Convention
- Aimed at facilitating closer collaboration between CESDEN and UNECE SC ESD and at integrating expertise of Cyprus
 - Implemented by Spirala Network in 2024 2025
 - Looking for closer collaboration with Serbian experts and partners in 2025, in order to co-organize Carpathian ESD Seminar in Serbia (envisioned in Spring 2025) and follow up on its results
