

# Meeting Venue:

#### **Accommodation:**

With the diverse range of accommodation options available in Bratislava, it is advisable to search for the most suitable lodging for your stay and make the necessary arrangements. Given Bratislava's popularity as a tourist destination, we recommend making reservations well in advance to ensure availability during your visit.

Some of the hotels with fair reviews, from where the meeting venue is easily accessible either by the bus or by longer walk are the following:

# <u>Transportation to the meeting venue by public transportation:</u>

#### 1. From the airport to the meeting venue:

- a. Bus No. 61: Connects Bratislava Airport (Letisko) to the Main Railway Station (Hlavná železničná stanica). Buses run approximately every 15 minutes from early morning until late evening. The journey takes about 25-35 minutes, depending on traffic. Tickets cost €1.10 for a 30-minute validity and can be purchased at ticket machines located at the bus stop or inside the terminal. Remember to validate your ticket upon boarding.
- b. By Taxi: Airport Taxi Services: Official airport taxis are available outside the Arrivals Terminal. The journey to the Water Research Institute typically takes around 15-20 minutes, depending on traffic. Fares should be clearly displayed; however, it's advisable to confirm the estimated fare with the driver before starting your trip. (Tip: Use official taxi services or apps like Bolt or Uber to avoid overcharging)













# 2. Bus from the main railway Bratislava station (Bratislava Hlavna)

a. Transfer to Bus No. 93 & 31, 39: From the Main Railway Station, you can transfer to Bus No. 93 until Zochova bus station, where bus 31 and 39 will take you closer to the Water Research Institute (Kráľovské údolie bus station).

# **Additional Tips:**

- Ticket Purchase and Validation: Bus tickets are available from ticket machines at bus stops or inside the terminal. After purchasing, validate your ticket upon boarding to avoid fines.
- Route Planning: Utilize the official Bratislava public transportation website or mobile apps like Google Maps for real-time schedules and route planning to ensure the most efficient journey.

#### **Other relevant information:**

Slovakia observes Central European Time (CET, UTC +1).

The official currency in Slovakia is the **Euro** (€). Credit cards are widely accepted, but it's useful to have some cash for small purchases.
