

8. About Veselí nad Moravou:

Veselí nad Moravou is a picturesque town in the South Moravian Region of the Czech Republic, known for its rich history, cultural traditions, biodiversity, and scenic location along the Morava River. The nearby Baťa Canal contributes to a dynamic landscape. Veselí is an important gateway to the Lower Morava Biosphere Reserve, a key protected area with diverse wetland and floodplain ecosystems that are home to rare plant and animal species, and to the White Carpathians (Bílé Karpaty), a Protected Landscape Area as well as UNESCO Biosphere Reserve.





9. Field Trip

Bílé Karpaty is a stunning region at the westernmost part of the Carpathian range, famous for its extremely high species richness, particularly its valuable orchid meadows, and unique landscape, where traditional farming methods are preserved, including small-scale orchards.

During the field trip on Wednesday, 14 May, we will visit some of the characteristic locations near Veselí, in the company of guides from the Protected Landscape Area administration. We will also have the opportunity to see some examples of local nature restoration.

We will leave for the field trip right after lunch (at 13:30) by bus and will come back to Veselí around 6 pm. Please bring suitable outdoor shoes and a raincoat/umbrella for the field trip.
