

Organisation process within the ABB



- Recent launch of the Core Group on Nature Restoration
- The group is currently developing a work plan for 2025-2026 enabling :

 - Building of a solid network of restoration experts
- Contribution to the Alpine Biodiversity Plan by the beginning of 2026

- Technical Workshops in 2025/26 on:
 - Identifying transboundary/alpine-wide restoration
 - action to be considered in National Restoration Plans

- Strategic meetings with national experts, formal validation through our permanent committees
