


Map of wind power plants, screenshot Carpathian Mountains





UKRAINIAN CARPATHIANS

- 10% of Carpathian mountain system
- Less than 4% of the territory of Ukraine
- High altitude zone (over 900 m.a.s.l.) less than 1% of the territory of Ukraine
- **The only** accessible mountain area in Ukraine at the moment (Crimean mountains are occupied)

UKRAINIAN CARPATHIANS

- Home to 2000 species of flora and hundreds species of fauna, among both – endemic and rare species, 2/3 of biodiversity of Ukraine
- Unique landscapes and ecosystems
- Migratory paths for birds and large carnivores
- Guarantee of environmental balance

SUMMARY Report on violations of Ukrainian legislation in the field of environmental protection and urban planning during the construction of wind farms in the highlands of the Ukrainian Carpathians Prepared by environmental and public organizations in Zakarpattia region, Ukraine

Key facts:

- Projects that violate the law: LLC "MC" "WIND PARKS OF UKRAINE" and its subsidiary LLC "Friendly Windtechnology" have plans for wind energy development on nine of the thirteen high mountain ranges of the Ukrainian Carpathians in violation of nature conservation and urban planning laws.
- Illegal construction zones: these projects are being implemented in areas covered by the Emerald Network, affecting primeval forests, protected natural areas, and habitats of species listed in the Red Book of Ukraine without legal basis and/or proper environmental impact assessments.

- Manipulation of the legislative framework: companies use a dubious scheme of fragmenting the project and dividing it into small sub-projects in order to circumvent the proper procedures, starting preparatory construction work before obtaining legal permits.
- Destruction of nature: roads and turbine foundations are being built in ecologically sensitive and geologically unstable highaltitude areas. To build a forest asphalt road to one of the mountain pastures, which is the site for the construction of a wind farm, logging was carried out in the primeval forest, which is prohibited by law.


- Corruption and collusion: regional authorities, state forestry enterprises and law enforcement agencies are complicit. They facilitate illegal logging, ignore violations, falsify documents and suppress investigations.
- Dishonesty: dozens of limited liability companies with minimal capital are registered to blur legal responsibility, conceal ownership and avoid accountability.

- Crackdown on environmental defenders: environmentalists, journalists and local activists face intimidation, cyberattacks, well-organized smear and defamation campaigns, workplace harassment and legal threats.
- Local community opposition: thousands of residents have signed petitions against the projects. Some citizens have been pressured or manipulated to change their position through economic coercion and intimidation. The following report, prepared by experts from environmental NGOs based on two years of fieldwork, analysis of open sources and information from requests for access to public information, describes all of the above statements in detail.

















REAL-LIFE THREATS

Fragmentation and loss of eco-corridors.

Loss of preconditions for sustainable local economic development, sustainable rural tourism and agriculture.

Attack on number of key ecosystem services, including water accumulation function.

Complete loss of the separate populations of flora and fauna, in particular primeval forests.

Loss of aesthetics of natural landscapes.

Expansion of invasive species of grass plants (Heracleum sosnowskyi Manden).

WE CALL CARPATHIAN COMMUNITY FOR SUPPORT

Request to the CCIC to develop resolution asking Ukrainian government to stop any interventions in the high altitude areas of Ukrainian Carpathians until:

- the Analysis of Wind Potential Areas in Ukrainian Carpathians is being elaborated by the group of independent experts, including no-go areas, and
- the cross-border Environmental Impact Assessment led by the international group of independent scientists, is done.
